



Instructions for Authors (Papers must be received by June 15, 1998)

The conference proceedings will be published on CD-ROM (see Instructions for Electronic Paper Submission) and printed in paper form from the camera-ready hard copy you provide. Be sure to follow formatting and submission instructions carefully. Your failure to do so may jeopardize the inclusion of your paper in the conference proceedings.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Limit paper length to five pages.
 - Provide laser printer output of 8 1/2 in. x 11 in. pages.
 - Set top, left, and right margins at 1/2 in.
 - Set bottom margin to 1 in.
 - Do not place anything outside the margins.
 - Type two columns per page (with a 1/4 in. gutter between columns).
 - Cut A4 paper to 11 in. (28 cm) if necessary.
 - Use 14 point Times Bold, initial caps, for the title.
 - Center the title of your paper across the entire image area.
 - Double space between the title of the paper and the author(s) name(s).
 - Center the author(s) name(s).
 - Use 12 point Times Regular, initial caps, for the author(s) name(s).
 - Double space between the author(s) name(s) and the affiliation.
 - Center the affiliation; include E-mail address.
 - Use 12 point Times Regular, initial caps, for the affiliation.
 - Double space, and begin your paper (format in two columns).
 - Begin your paper with an abstract.
 - Type **ABSTRACT** and other major headings in 10 point Times Bold, all caps.
 - Center major headings within the column.
 - Use Roman numerals to number all major headings. Do not number either the abstract or the references section.
 - Use 10 point Times with line spacing of 12 for the body of your paper.
- Use block format (do not indent paragraphs) and justify text.
 - Double space between paragraphs and before and after section headings.
 - Use 10 point Times Italic, initial caps, for subheadings.
 - Align subheadings with the left-hand margin of the column. Use alpha numbering (i.e., A, B, C, etc.).
 - Center equations in the column, with the equation number enclosed in parentheses and aligned with the right-hand margin of the column.
 - Position photos, figures, and tables within the text.
 - Place table title above the table; place figure caption below the figure.
 - Keep in mind that the paper version of the conference proceedings will be printed in black and white. Plan your illustrations for maximum legibility. Keep patterns simple and shading to a minimum.
 - Number all pages in pencil on the back of the page.
 - Do not fold camera-ready pages.

Receipt of your manuscript, along with the IEEE Copyright Form, constitutes release for publication. No cancellation of such release is permissible. Do not send your manuscript if it has not been cleared for publication.

DEADLINE

To be included in the conference proceedings, your manuscript must be received by **June 15, 1998**.
